**Eligibility:**

Qualified applicants must be a graduating high school senior from St. Louis City or St. Louis County High School. A GPA of (2.4 on a 4.0 scale) or better is required and the applicant must have been accepted to a college or university to be eligible to receive the award. The scholarship will be awarded based on financial need, proposed use, and overall qualifications, with emphasis on the quality of the required essay.

**Instructions for candidates:**

The following are required to complete your application:

- Official High School Transcript(s)
- A 500-word essay on one of the topics provided;
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or school administrator;
- A letter of acceptance to an institution of higher learning (required to receive the award);
- Signed Release Form (enclosed);
- Parent's/guardian's signature if student is under 18 years old;
- Resume
- Complete all forms in their entirety; Attach additional pages if needed;
- Incomplete packages will automatically be disqualified;

## Essay Topic and Requirements:

Write a 500-word essay (typed in your own words) on one of the following 3 topics.

- **What impact did the Buffalo Soldiers make in war and / or peacetime and how does this inspire you? Or (2) Why is it necessary to pass this legacy on to future generations? Or (3) Using the philosophies of the original Buffalo Soldiers, how would you apply what you have learned in your community?**
- **Typed/Digital Uploaded**
- **Double Spaced**
- **Times New Roman 12 Point Font**
- **1” Margins**
- **Sources must come from a combination of the following mediums: magazines, books, and the Internet.**
- **You are responsible for properly citing your references to avoid any form of plagiarism. Any plagiarized content will disqualify your application.**
